We look back on fiscal year 2010 with gratitude for the contributions of the many people that helped make the year a success. This year was one of searching for new ways to close financial gaps that opened when we experienced three cuts in our state funding and needed to find opportunities to makeup that deficit. With every department pulling together we were able to find the resources to continue providing services at the same level as in years past.

One of our successes was applying for and obtaining grants from the city and state to allow us to perform much needed improvements on a number of our homes. We received funding to renovate the interiors of homes that hadn't seen new kitchens for over 40 years. We renovated bathrooms to allow full handicapped access. We replaced siding, doors, windows, and added insulation in homes to make them more energy efficient. We participated in city energy audits that provided us with information to prioritize for energy efficient measures for upcoming years.

An ongoing challenge is how to continue to offer health insurance to our staff that is adequate and affordable. We were able to institute a HRA (Health Reimbursement Account) which is funded using pre-tax dollars, saving staff and CLI money. While not a complete solution, it has helped those who participate to save money in the long run. Our goal for the New Year is to institute a Wellness Program for the staff to promote all around good health.

We are always on the lookout for opportunities that will enhance the lives of our people. Sports are one way that socialization meets healthy living. Our people love to snowshoe, kayak, play bocce and a variety of team sports. In 2010 our individuals played on a city sponsored Kickball league. We may not have won any games, but the wonderful experiences far outweighed anything imaginable. Our folks learned about sportsmanship, teamwork and to lose graciously. The other teams learned tolerance, to have fun and not to take things so seriously. We hope to continue improving in kickball and adding other sports in the future. Our hope is to secure sponsorship in the future to not only continue with kickball, but add other team sports as well.

2011 is sure to present new challenges and opportunities. Working together, we will be prepared to meet those challenges and continue to provide homes and supports that are directed by the individuals we serve and that involve families and the community which enables persons with developmental disabilities to be happy, healthy, safe and LIVE LIFE!
